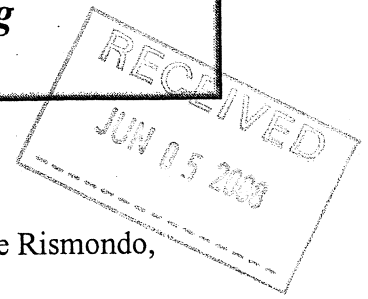


Beardmore School Community Council Meeting
