All schools of the Superior-Greenstone District School Board will be reopened for in-person learning on Monday, January 11, 2021.

The Ministry announcement made yesterday, on January 7th, advised that they have decided to extend the provincewide shutdown for another 14 days. Please note that the extension of the shutdown will NOT impact busing services for students and the buses will run, except where announcements have been made for driver shortages.

All Students are reminded to return any learning assistive devices, such as laptops and iPads, back to the school on Monday.

Our Students' safety and health are our top priorities.
