

ROLE OF THE BOARD NTIP STEERING COMMITTEE

- Conduct a minimum of two yearly meetings
- Promote and facilitate the program within the schools and throughout the Board
- Participate in Board Orientation session if available
- Provide input into completion of the NTIP Continuum
- Develop criteria/goals/expectations at the Board level
- Evaluate and identify positives, negatives and next steps for the program
- Facilitate workshops and teacher training by offering training sessions or by finding trainers to bring in
- Conduct union/federation presentations
- Assist with sustaining the program

COMPOSITION OF THE NTIP STEERING COMMITTEE: Membership should be voluntary. Members can be nominated by self, a peer or an administrator. Members should represent various aspects of our education community. Suggested representation:

- 1 Board Lead
- 1 Human Resources representative
- 1-2 mentors from each panel
- 1-2 new teachers from each panel
- 1 Principal or Vice-Principal from each panel
- Union representation
