Regional studies/Native Language conference this year - not sure if it will occur this year

Increase with Native Studies program – funding increase

New text books for Native Studies have been distributed and are now also in French

Goal of toolkit woven across the curriculum - Board is working on an implementation plan

Professional Development that occurred with First Nation schools – we cannot send our teachers to this conference, although we would have paid –

e-learning courses and accesses to the Ontario curriculum resource bank – now extended to the First Nation Schools (Federal Schools)

Yvonne Morrision has asked that we update her on the status of the first Nation self Id Policy Chris McLeod = will do presentation on Metis to this committee

Metis kit is also available - focus is on elementary students

We will be purchasing some of these resources

Native Language/Native Study Symposium
