Superior-Greenstone District School Board to Rotate Face-to-Face Meetings

MARATHON, Ontario – At the Regular Board Meeting on March 29, 2004, the Superior-Greenstone District School Board voted to implement a rotation for the sites it will convene its face-to-face Board Meetings in 2004. Where the face-to-face meetings were scheduled to take place at the Marathon Board Office location in April, June and September 2004, these will now be held at the following high school sites. The public portion of the Board Meetings will start at 11:30 a.m.

- *Friday, April 16, 2004. Nipigon Red Rock District High School, Red Rock, ON*
- *Friday, June 18, 2004 Geraldton Composite High School, Geraldton, ON*
- *Friday, September 17, 2004 Lake Superior High School, Terrace Bay, ON*

The Board's Organizational Meeting on December 3, 2004 will remain at the Marathon Board Office location.

In conjunction with establishing a rotation for the Board meetings, the Board of Trustees intends to hold its Joint School Council Meetings and conduct school tours in the area community schools during the evening preceding the Board Meeting

The Board feels that the rotation of board meetings in its area school communities will afford a better opportunity for the public to periodically have personal access to live Board Meeting proceedings. As well, the coupling of Joint School Council meetings and school tours with the rotating Board Meetings allows the Board to build stronger relationships with the constituents it serves. It expects that this change will work toward a goal of getting to know constituents better and provide a forum for sharing highlights in student learning environments and programme growth.

A Joint School Council Meeting is planned this month at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 15, 2004 at the George O'Neill Public School in Nipigon.
