7.0 Report from the Superintendent of Business

7.1 Special Board Report No. 04: Estimates for 2013-2014

Superintendent of Business C. Tsubouchi reviewed Report No. 04 in detail indicating that the Budget Estimates presented is fully compliant with ministry regulations. There is a deficit for compliance purposes of \$68,000. Such compliance deficits are permitted under the Education Act. Projected revenues for the Board is \$36 million. There is PSAB surplus of \$465,000 and an over expenditure in Special Education. The estimates are based on a total enrolment of 1497 FTE students which is down by 60 FTE from 2012-2013 actual enrolment.
