Background

A tender for the construction of the GCHS-BAPS Childcare Addition, Interior Alterations and Site Improvements had been advertised on MERX (Canada's electronic tendering services for government contract) and five compliant bids were received.

Current Situation:

The lowest tender bid, which met all the requirements of the specification, was submitted by M-Builds (NWO) Limited, in the amount of \$ 9,121,000 before HST.

The low bid amount received was higher than the funding received by the Ministry. Consultation with the Ontario Government Capital Branch Analyst, Financial Analyst and Childcare Analyst was undertaken to secure additional funding. The additional funding needed has been secured.

It is recommended that the tender contract for the GCHS-BAPS Childcare Addition, Alterations, Site improvements (Project # 1743) be awarded to M-Builds (NWO) Limited.
