 - School has a population of 58 students in the elementary and 70 in the secondary panel.
 - There are 5 elementary teaching staff, 9 secondary staff.
 - Different schedules, entrance times—elementary and secondary school operate as separate entities.
 - Examples of activities that involve the entire school; e.g. Christmas concert, Wake-a-thon.
 - There is a sharing of facilities such as the science lab, art room and shop. The library has two seminar rooms off of the library equipped with white boards.

Staffing:

• Elementary and secondary staffing continues to be two separate unions and is therefore staffed independent of each other.

Questions:

- How would our high school students feel with other students entering this high school? (if need be a further call could be made to Ignace as they have also moved an elementary school into a High school
- How do the Unions feel about being in the same building? (Doesn't seem to be problematic)
