# 7.1 <u>Showcasing Learning: Nakina Public School: Making a Difference</u>

The Director of Education Nicole Morden Cormier introduced the showcasing learning presentation video that highlighted how Nakina Public School made a difference during Random Acts of Kindness week. The video showcased students learning and spreading kindness through random phone calls with positive messages for their community members. The activity provided students the opportunity to learn communication skills, the importance of global citizenship and how to positively impact their community.

7.2 <u>Excellence in Education: Marathon High School Presentation Titled: A Love of Learning</u>
Principal Stephen Wilson of Marathon High School presented the many ways his students have demonstrated a love of learning. He advised that students are grateful for the opportunity to

return to learning within the school building amongst their peers. The opportunities provided to students include hands on learning, bully prevention work, kindness initiatives, connecting with the community, and connecting with the land. The initiatives reflect the Multi-Year Strategic Plan and how the school is focused on learning, well-being, stewardship and building positive relationships.
