4.0 Presentations

4.1 Distance Learning: The Voice of Students

Student Trustees Sydney Schwantz and Stephanie Rathwell provided the presentation regarding distance learning. Information for the presentation was collected from students at the May 12th Virtual Student Senate meeting as well as an anonymous survey that was completed by over 40 students. The presentation highlighted the advantages and disadvantages of distance learning. The Student Senate consists of 2-3 Student representatives from each school.

4.2 Ensuring Smooth Transitions During COVID-19

Carole Leroux, Student Success Lead discussed the work that has begun to help ensure a smooth transition to grade 9 for students. All High Schools and representatives from each of the schools that feed in to the high schools will work in collaboration to prepare students for the transition. A plan will be created to assist students in their transition whether we return to the physical school buildings or virtual learning in the fall.

Hillary Freeburn, Early Years Lead, presented the "Welcome to Kindergarten Season 2020-2021" information. The presentation included the registration process, getting to know the student and their families, know the staff, and resources for students on how to be attentive, listening and responding. To make sure that families have everything they need to be successful for the start of school collaboration continues with the EarlyOn centres. Planning has begun for Welcome to kindergarten parades, face book page, learning and getting to know you, as well as information sessions on how to join classes virtually.

5.1 <u>Director's Report</u>

The Director of Education provided a detailed review of her report. She discussed the Ministry announcement that was provided recently as well as the planning taking place for the preparation of a safe reopening of schools.
