We are writing to inform you of a water quality matter currently being reviewed at B.A. Parker Public School and Geraldton Composite High School.

On April 30th, water discolouration was observed at both schools. As a precaution, we are working closely with the appropriate authorities to investigate the situation and ensure the continued safety and quality of the water in our schools.

Out of an abundance of caution, we have begun providing potable drinking water for students and staff at both schools, starting April 30th. All other water services—such as restrooms, handwashing, and cleaning—remain operational.

The health and safety of our students and staff remain our top priority, and we are taking all necessary steps to address the matter thoroughly. We appreciate your understanding and support as we work through this process.
