## Kindergarten: The Extended Day Program

The Extended Day program provides parents of students in kindergarten to age twelve with access to before and after school care in our Full Day-Early Learning Schools.

Extended Day programs are available where sufficient requests warrant establishing a program. Each year during registration, the District School Board will survey parents of Junior Kindergarten students to determine the need for a program.

District School Boards may run their own programs at a designated full day kindergarten site or where there is an existing, eligible third party child care operator in the school, the school board can enter into an agreement with that child care organization.
