#### 7.2.1 Keewatin Patricia DSB-Orion Project

The Northern Ontario Educational Leaders have successfully lobbied for school boards' inclusion to access the improved technology services being implemented with the building of a provincial broadband network called the Orion. This will assist with programming issues for classes and teacher upgrading.

#### 7.2.2 Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities

Diane Cunningham, Minister of Training, Colleges and Universities confirmed receipt of the Board's correspondence to the Ministry wherein our support was indicated for the Township of Schreiber's proposal for the establishment of an Ontario Municipal Employee Training Program. Schreiber's proposal continues to be studied.

#### Update: Early Reading Strategy-Regional Trainer 7.3.1

The Ministry has for the Early Reading Strategy; Regional Trainer for Northwestern Ontario selected Nancy Bailey, a teacher at Dorion Public School.

#### 7.3.2 Update: Schools that Need Extra Help

Anticipated funding for this project was \$100,000 for this school year. However, after a review of the comprehensive proposal submitted by the Margaret Twomey Project Team, the Ministry has advised that \$200,000 is being allocated. The additional funding will assist in setting up videoconference links at the school and the provision of extensive resource material for students

#### 7.3.3 **David Bouchard Presentations**

Literacy expert David Bouchard is doing a tour of schools for the Superior North Catholic DSB between March 31 and April 2. Sessions at our coterminous boards' schools in Longlac, Marathon, Manitouwadge and Schreiber are open to our schools' teachers and parents.
