An investigation into the cost of leasing vehicles for high schools to serve the travel needs of trustees, school administration and student groups was found costs to be prohibitively high. Effective November 1, 2003 the allowanc for employees who use their own vehicle for approved school board business will increase to 0.42 cents per kilometre for the first 5,000 kilometres in a school year. For travel in excess of 5,000 kilometres in a school year, the allowance is set at 0.36 cents per kilometre
