The results from the EQAO May 2003 student assessments show a constant, gradual improvement with both grade 3 and 6 students performing close to the provincial level in reading, writing and math. In grade 3, there were 143 students tested, while in grade 6, testing was done with 172 students. Results were below the provincial average in all areas for Grade 3 students. Grade 6 students were above the provincial average in reading, at the provincial level in writing and slightly below the province's math level. By analyzing data from the assessments, school improvement plans are established.
