P. Pella provided a comprehensive review of the Grade 9 EQAO 2003 Math Results. At area high schools, 172 Grade 9 Academic Math students and 182 students in Applied Math wrote the test that reflects student learning up to grade 9. The gender split was even among the writers. The provincial average for applied level students achieving at Level 3 (high) was 23%. Overall, 27% of our applied math students' achieved a Level 3 result. At the academic level, 59% of students scored at Level 3, while 2% of students scored very high to outstanding (Level 4).
