13.2 <u>Student Performance Bill: Professional Development Days</u>

Director P. Pella provided a verbal update in regard to the Student Performance Bill that provides an additional two professional development days within the school year bringing the total allotment to six days. The ministry has guidelines for boards to schedule the two extra days. Administration is meeting with coterminous boards to determine placement of the days to achieve the best alignment of the days within the four boards.

13.3 Trustee Remuneration Committee

P. Pella provided a verbal report on the implementation of new levels of trustee honoraria. Regulation 357/06 requires boars to establish a policy in this matter by October 31, 2006. Policy development requires input from a citizen's advisory committee consisting of six people serving on School Councils. The group would make recommendations for two different periods of remuneration for trustees. The first is retroactive to September 1, 2005 up to November 30, 2006. The second recommendation would cover trustee honoraria for the new term of office for trustees. Trustee, D. Keenan asked that he board consider sending a letter of support for the isolate boards whose trustees as a result of the formula established by the ministry will have substantially less honoraria than trustees elected to the district school boards.

Bruce Rousseau reported that the 2006-2007 Budget Estimates comply with the Ministry of Education's enveloping and accountability requirements. He noted that this year, an approximate shortfall of \$3 million in funding is a result of changes in the ministry funding formula.. He provided an overview of the budget explaining that although the budget is balanced it is not sustainable. Staffing reductions and approximately 15% cost efficiencies in the in operating budgets, along with using \$242,329 from Working Reserves balances the budget this year. Administration continues to put forward its concerns to the ministry regarding the negative impact the revised funding formula is having on many boards, especially the small northern boards.

E-mail correspondence from David Blanchard, a former student trustee to Director Patti Pella regarding the installation of the track at Lake Superior HS was reported. His note outlines concern over the reduction of size of the soccer pitch area at LSHS to accommodate the track. Trustee K. Notwell advised she had fielded similar comments in the community. Manager of Plant Wayne Chiupka noted that with the school and community request to install the track was a strong lobby. As such, administration and the board considered the request a priority and followed through. In its planning stages the concern being raised now was not evident and the project proceeded. He advised that although the soccer pitch is reduced, the field had always been less than regulation size.
