Principal Kim Ransom of Margaret Twomey PS provided an overview of the Family of Schools strategy that has been implemented within the system. He noted that his role at the elementary panel level is to facilitate and provide expertise and coaching with the intent to align the family of schools with common language and focus on best practices for student achievement. To begin, an environmental scan of each school is scheduled to examine classrooms supports for learning. Baseline data will be collected to help measure outcomes.
