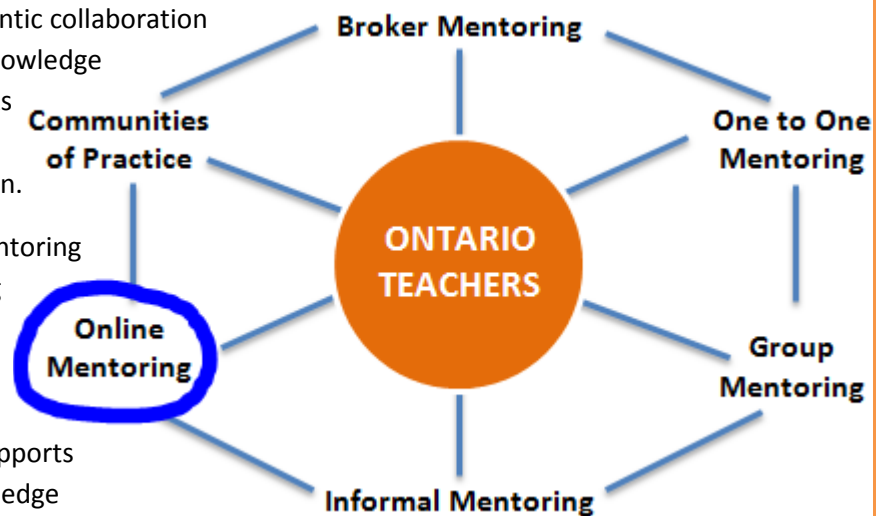


Building a Mentoring Web Across Ontario
