



## **NOTICE – Classes Cancelled due to COVID-19/Coronavirus**

### **ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS and SECONDARY SCHOOLS**

**There will be no school for Elementary and High School students beginning Monday, March 16, 2020 and continuing until Friday, April 3, 2020. Classes will resume on Monday, April 6, 2020.**

Superior-Greenstone District School Board was informed yesterday afternoon that, based on advice from Dr. David Williams, Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health and the experts at the COVID-19 Command Table, the Minister of Education has issued a Ministerial Order to close all publicly funded schools in Ontario for two weeks following March break, in response to the emergence in Ontario of COVID-19.

This means that Ontario schools, including the schools of the Superior-Greenstone District School Board, have been ordered to remain closed from March 14 through to April 5, 2020.

During this time, we continue to encourage parents to adhere to the information provided by Public Health (please see our SGDSB website for links) and to observe travel advisories. This situation continues to change at a rapid pace, and we encourage everyone to stay informed. Information will continue to be posted to the [sgdsb.on.ca](http://sgdsb.on.ca) website.
