


## Steps to add SGDSB Wireless to Android Devices

To simplify setup, you can install the Domain Certificate [here](#).

1. On main screen, swipe down options menu
2. Select Settings, or settings gear (as on right)




3. Ensure Wi-fi is turned on, then click on it.



4. Find "SGDSBStaff" and click on it.  
If you cannot find it:
  - a. Ensure you are near an access point
  - b. Go to "Add Wi-Fi Network" at the bottom.
  - c. Enter "SGDSBStaff" for Network SSID (Letter are case sensitive)
  - d. Enter 802.1x EAP for security and enter settings as below

5. Settings should be as follows:
  - a. EAP Method: PEAP
  - b. Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2
  - c. CA certificate: (unspecified)
  - d. User certificate: (unspecified)
  - e. Identity: you board username to log into computers
  - f. Anonymous identity: (leave blank)
  - g. Password: The password for your board account
  - h. Click Connect



6. You should now be connected to the "SGDSBStaff" network
7. Open your web browser and login to the Wireless Portal to enable internet access.
