


Steps to Add SGDSB Wireless to Computers with Windows 7

To simplify setup, you can install the Domain Certificate [here](#). If it is installed, Skip to step 12

1. Right click on the wireless icon at the bottom right and click "Open Network and Sharing Center"




2. On the right side of the Network and Sharing Center Window, click "Manage wireless networks"

3. On the next window click Add

4. Select "Manually create a network profile"

5. Enter the following information on the next screen:
 - a. Network name: SGDSBStaff (this is case sensitive)
 - b. Security Type: WPA2-Enterprise
 - c. Encryption type: AES
 - d. Ensure "Start this connection automatically" is checked
 - e. Click Next



6. On the next screen click "Change connection settings"

7. Click on the security tab, check to make sure "Choose a network authentication method" is set to Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP) and click Settings

8. Uncheck "Validate server certificate" and click on Configure next to Secured password

9. Uncheck "Automatically use my Windows login name and password and click OK

10. Click OK on the "Protected EAP Properties" windows and click OK on the SGDSBStaff Wireless Network Properties" window

11. Click on Close on "Manually connect to a wireless network" and Close the "Manage Wireless Networks" window

12. Click on the wireless icon at the bottom right. This should bring up a list of available wireless networks.

13. Click on SGDSBStaff and click connect

14. A windows should pop up asking you to enter your credentials. Enter you username and password you use to login to school computers or you board email



15. Open your web browser and login to the Wireless Portal to enable internet access.
