### **Background**

On April 22, 2013, Report No. 31: Elementary Teaching Staff Proposal for September 2013 (see attached) was presented as information to provide Trustees time to review before a recommendation would come forward at the May 6, 2013 Special Board Meeting.

#### **Current Situation**

Staffing our schools is extremely important to the lives of our students, teachers, administrators and communities. Intervention programs and school organization contributes to the positive learning environments that we celebrate in each of our schools. It is necessary to examine each school in our Board to determine staffing levels that will best meet the needs of our students and at the same time align resources to benefit our students.

Board decisions about school-based staff allocations take into account legislative requirements including the Ministry of Education's Primary Class Size (PCS), available resources, as well as our guiding principles;

- Low pupil teacher ratio when determining staffing for multi-age classrooms
- Flexibility in responding to the needs of schools experiencing an increase in enrolment in September 2013.

Superior-Greenstone District School Board is committed to the success of every student. Although there are many multiple grade classroom configurations in our elementary schools, this staffing proposal continues to address the cognitive, emotional, physical and academic development of our students.

Table 1 outlines the recommended classroom staffing compared to the 2012/2013 school year and Table 2 outlines the recommended Special Education and French/Primary planning staffing.

### **Current Situation**

Staffing our schools is extremely important to the lives of our students, teachers, administrators and communities. Intervention programs and school organization contributes to the positive learning environments that we celebrate in each of our schools. It is necessary to examine each school in our Board to determine staffing levels that will best meet the needs of our students and at the same time align resources to benefit our students. Our commitment to the three core priorities of the Ministry of Education; increased levels of student achievement, reducing the gap in student achievement and increased public confidence continues to be our focus as we move forward in this process.

In consultation with school administrators, the following guiding principles have been used to staff our school in September 2013:

- Low pupil teacher ratio is a major consideration when determining staffing for multi-age classrooms;
   An attempt to eliminate quadruple grades in the literacy and numeracy blocks and limit the pupil-teacher ratio to 15:1 will be a focus
- Flexibility in responding to the needs of schools experiencing an increase in enrolment in September 2013

Although there are many multiple grade classroom configurations in our elementary schools, this staffing proposal continues to meet the cognitive, emotional and physical needs of our students.
